2020 models with the Stop/Start system.

We have been advised by our local Fiat Service Workshop that the engine management system disables this system when it detects a low voltage in the starter battery. To preserve the start battery the system begins turning off non-essential systems and the Start/Stop system is one of the first. If you have noticed the star/stop system indicating a fault one day and then working OK on another day this will be the reason. Plugging your motorhome into a mains supply will charge the start battery and will help prevent this from happening.

Workshop

Our new workshop is going well, the Service team certainly like it. By the end of June we will have a 6 ton vehicle hoist in place which will expand the services that we can offer. Once the hoist is operational, we will be able to install the Goldschmitt Air Suspension and Levelling systems that Zion Motorhomes have been able to do in the North Island.
